CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN MOTORCYCLE SPORTING EVENT AND/OR ACTIVITY

1. I (RIDER).....

HEREBY AGREE with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in schedule 1 (hereinafter collectively called "the organiser") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity / meeting listed in schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the meeting") at the venue listed in schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

2. **I ACKNOWLEDGE** that motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and by participating in the meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under a certain obligation as follows:-
- a) That I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - b) That my machinery or equipment may be damaged, or lost or destroyed
 - c) That other competitors may ride dangerously or with lack of skill;
 - d) That track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability.
 - e) That organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
 - f) That any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided.
 - g) That there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured.
 - h) That I have an obligation to myself and to others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.

INDEMNITY TO THE ORGANISERS

3. **IN CONSIDERATION** of acceptance of me as an entrant in the meeting **I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY** the organisers and each of them in the following manner;
- a) That I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
 - b) That I accept the venue as it stands with all defects hidden or exposed;
 - c) That I indemnify and hold harmless the organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials against any actions or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf or by other parties for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or to my machinery or equipment whether caused by negligence breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.

SCRUTINEERING: **7.30am - 8.30am**

RIDER'S BRIEF: **8.30am (SHARP)**

RIDING BEGINS: FROM 9.00am – 5.00pm. First session (OPEN ALL POWERS) off and running at 9.00am sharp!

RIDE FORMAT: 12 MINUTE SESSIONS FOR EACH CLASS, OVER AN 8 HOUR PERIOD

ALL RIDERS: Must sign in on the day. (INDEMNITY FORM)
Must bring official Receipt book on the day. No Receipt Book = No Entry
Must produce Club membership card and M.A licence (if held) at sign in.

IF NO LICENCE IS HELD YOU MUST:

A. Purchase a one day non-competition licence for \$20 on the day, or Purchase a \$55 12 month rec. licence on the day, which then entitles you to ride at all Broadford MX open practice days, and all Super Saturday's for the next 12 months. (Please indicate on entry form if you require a 1-day licence or club membership)

SPONSORSHIP: RIDERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO OBTAIN SPONSORSHIP IN THE FORM OF A DONATION TO CHALLENGE. (Donations over \$2 are fully tax deductible). MACHINERY: All closed loop hand guards and side stands are to be removed, and handlebar ends to be plugged.
All machines must comply with the General Competition Rules of Motorcycling Australia.
In addition: All machines must comply with a 95db ride by at 30m as required by the Environment Protection Authority.

Machines over 95db will be black flagged immediately upon detection and disqualified from the event (no quietening or modifications once detected will be accepted as entry back in the event).

Subject to the Scrutineers approval of noise reduction measures the machine may be cleared to recommence racing. A second infringement will result in immediate black flagging and exclusion from the meeting.

Unregistered vehicles not entered in competition may not be used at a permitted event unless authorised by the Clerk of Course and under official supervision.
